
Key messages


- NCDs are the single biggest cause of death. 9 out of 10 deaths from NCDs before the age of 60 years of age occur in low- and middle-income countries.
- NCDs are a threat to economic development and they impede poverty reduction initiatives, including the MDGs.
- NCDs are preventable: there are cost-effective solutions that are affordable to all countries.
- There is a window of opportunity now to accelerate the implementation of the Action Plan of the Global Strategy for the Prevention and Control of NCDs (endorsed by the World **Heath Assembly in 2008)**

























- "Requests the President of the General Assembly to organize, no later than

 status with ECOSOC, civil society organizations, the private sector and
 academia, an informal interactive hearing with NGOs, civil society
 organizations, the private sector and academia to provide an input to the
 preparatory process for the High-level Meeting"
- "Decides that the President of the General Assembly shall preside over the above-mentioned informal interactive hearing, and requests the President of the General Assembly to prepare a summary of the hearing, to be issued as a document of the Assembly prior to the High-level meeting."




















Moscow Declaration

- A draft Declaration is being developed in consultation with Member States.
- The Moscow Declaration will be adopted by the participants of the First Global Ministerial Conference on Healthy Lifestyles and NCD Control (Moscow, 28-29 April 2011)
- It is envisaged that the Moscow Declaration will:
 - Highlight the challenges encountered by Member States in addressing NCDs
 - Include commitments to strengthen national efforts to address the burden of NCDs
 - Propose recommended actions on the prevention and control of NCDs that Heads of State and Government may wish to commit to at the High-level Meeting on NCDs (New York, 19-20 September 2011)
